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What happens inside a Fitness Tracker?

Most of the recent models have bluetooth that can connect to your phone so you get the information almost instantly. "Most modern fitness trackers use a three-axis accelerometer as their primary sensor. This advanced piece of technology measures acceleration based upon start of motion, end of motion, and intensity" (https://wonderopolis.org/wonder/how-do-fitnesstrackers-work).



And this data is put onto either a computer chip or iPhone application which translates the data from computer language to charts, graphs, and other forms of data.

Depending on what model you have they might have other sensors and additional features. Studies show that some recent types of Fitness Trackers actually overestimate weight loss and physical improvement. It can be a lie so don't get sucked in on the information. But most of the models are very helpful and focus more on your health and fitness levels, than steps. Which aren't as important to your overall wellness.



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
